SRI AUROBINDO'S RECOMMENDATIONS (15.8.1947)

- Recognition of peace & concord not enough
- Stress on 'common action, practice of common action & creation of means for that purpose'
- Exact form of Unity may have a pragmatic but not a fundamental importance



SRI AUROBINDO'S WARNINGS (15.8.1947)

IF REGIONAL UNITY IS NOT ACHIEVED:

- Civil strife may remain always possible
- A new invasion & foreign conquest can even be possible
- Internal development and prosperity impaired
- Weakening of India's position among nations, impairment and frustration of Her destiny



PROGRAM FOR COMMON ACTION

PRINCIPLE:

- Build up on a program for common action that would be acceptable to all and not perceived as imposition by force
- Avoid controversial issues like religious conflicts
- Address political systems without politicizing issues



STAGE 1 – PROGRAM FOR COMMON ACTION

AWARENESS GENERATION

Media, Website, Opinion Polls

- DIALOGUE
- **►** Initiation of multileveled dialogue –

People to people interaction, Academic dialogue, Dialogue among NGOs, Governmental dialogues

TIME-FRAME: Start now and intensely for 5 years



STAGE 2 – PROGRAM FOR COMMON ACTION

MOVE TO PRACTICAL EXCHANGE-AREAS OF COMMON INTEREST:

- Trade, commerce, business
- Hospitality industry
- Educational, Research & Technological exchange
- Communication Transit, Wireless, Wire line & internet
- Health
- Sports
- Culture
- Environmental Protection
- Poverty Alleviation program like microfinancing

TIME-FRAME: Start now and consolidate by 2015



STAGE 3 – PROGRAM FOR COMMON ACTION

SHIFT FROM EXCHANGE PROGRAMS TO PRO-ACTIVE INTERVENTION:

- Formation of Regional Supervisory Bodies for target areas chosen in Stage 2 viz. Federation of Industries, Regional Health Regulatory Body, Regional Sports Council etc.
- Setting up of a Regional university with affiliated institutions spread out. Designing of Special Courses on South Asia in various fields Economics, History, Education, Psychosocial Studies, International Relations, Cultural–Anthropological Studies, Religious studies

TIME-FRAME: Consolidate by 2020



STAGE 4 – PROGRAM FOR COMMON ACTION

- Consolidate the formation of South Asian Confederation
- Multiple Citizenship
- Regional Apex Bank and Common currency
- Common Defence Program, Regional military
- Central Confederation Headquarters and Regional branches
- Regional apex court
- Regional supervisory body that respects diversified, multiple unity

TIME-FRAME: Consolidate by 2025
